Guidelines for Attending

Whenever you feel you're ready to join us in person, *you'll be welcome – as long as you're willing to follow the current health and safety guidelines* (see below).

1. We will be doing our best to follow State Guidelines while in our building. This means we are asking you to help us ...
 - ... keep our group to 50% capacity (about 75-80 people) in the sanctuary. If we have more attending than that, overflow will go into the Fellowship Hall to watch the livestream service from there.
 - ... maintain appropriate social distancing (6 feet) between household groups coming into church and leaving, and in choosing a place to sit in the Sanctuary.
 - ... protect each person attending from getting infected by someone who may have the virus but is not experiencing any symptoms by:
 - checking your temperature before coming to church in the morning and staying home if it's elevated (99.5 or above)
 - wearing a mask while at church. If you don't have one, we will be happy to provide one for you when you come
 - generously using the provided hand sanitizer
 - not hugging or shaking hands with anyone outside of your family group
2. Building access is still restricted to the lobby, sanctuary, and bathrooms. The Fellowship Hall will only open up if we need it for overflow. These areas will be cleaned and disinfected before we open our building again and after each service as we do our part in following recommended safety guidelines.
3. The water fountains are still not available. We will have some bottles of water available. Feel free to bring some from home for you and your family.
4. We will not be handing out bulletins or passing the offering plates. Hymnals or Bibles will not be available in the pews for a while until the risk of infections become lower. Feel free to bring your own Bible from home.

5. It will still be a while until we get back into potlucks or breakfast.
6. If you are uncomfortable in any way with meeting don't hesitate to wait a bit longer before venturing back to our building – we will continue with our current livestream worship format for a while longer after we open up to continue providing a good experience for those participating from home.
